

Talk about the colors you see.	<b>11</b> Take your child to the library for story time.
<b>12</b> Read to your child for 10 minutes today.	<b>13</b> Talk to your child about car safety. Always buckle up!	<b>14</b> Read <i>The Snowman</i> by Raymond Briggs. Draw a snowman together.	<b>15</b> Talk about the color red. Have a red snack today.	<b>16</b> Give your child five of an item. Help her count them.	<b>17</b> Talk about the Wright Brothers. Pretend you are flying planes.	<b>18</b> Cut out paper snowflakes. Let your child decorate them.
<b>19</b> Look at the night sky together. Sing "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star."	<b>20</b> Make animals noises. Have your child guess the animal.	<b>21</b> Talk about the weather outside. Is it snowing? What is snow made of?	<b>22</b> Make shapes out of play-dough together. Talk about the colors and shapes.	<b>23</b> Have a treasure hunt! Hide a surprise for your child to find. Give them clues.	<b>24</b> Talk about animals that live in the snow.	<b>25</b> Play holiday music. Sing and dance together.
<b>26</b> Check out a book about animals. Pretend you are visiting the zoo. Talk about the animals.	<b>27</b> Read <i>Growing Vegetable Soup</i> by Lois Ehlert. Have a vegetable for a snack.	<b>28</b> Use a ruler to measure objects. Which one is bigger? Which one is smaller?	<b>29</b> Talk about the letter X.
