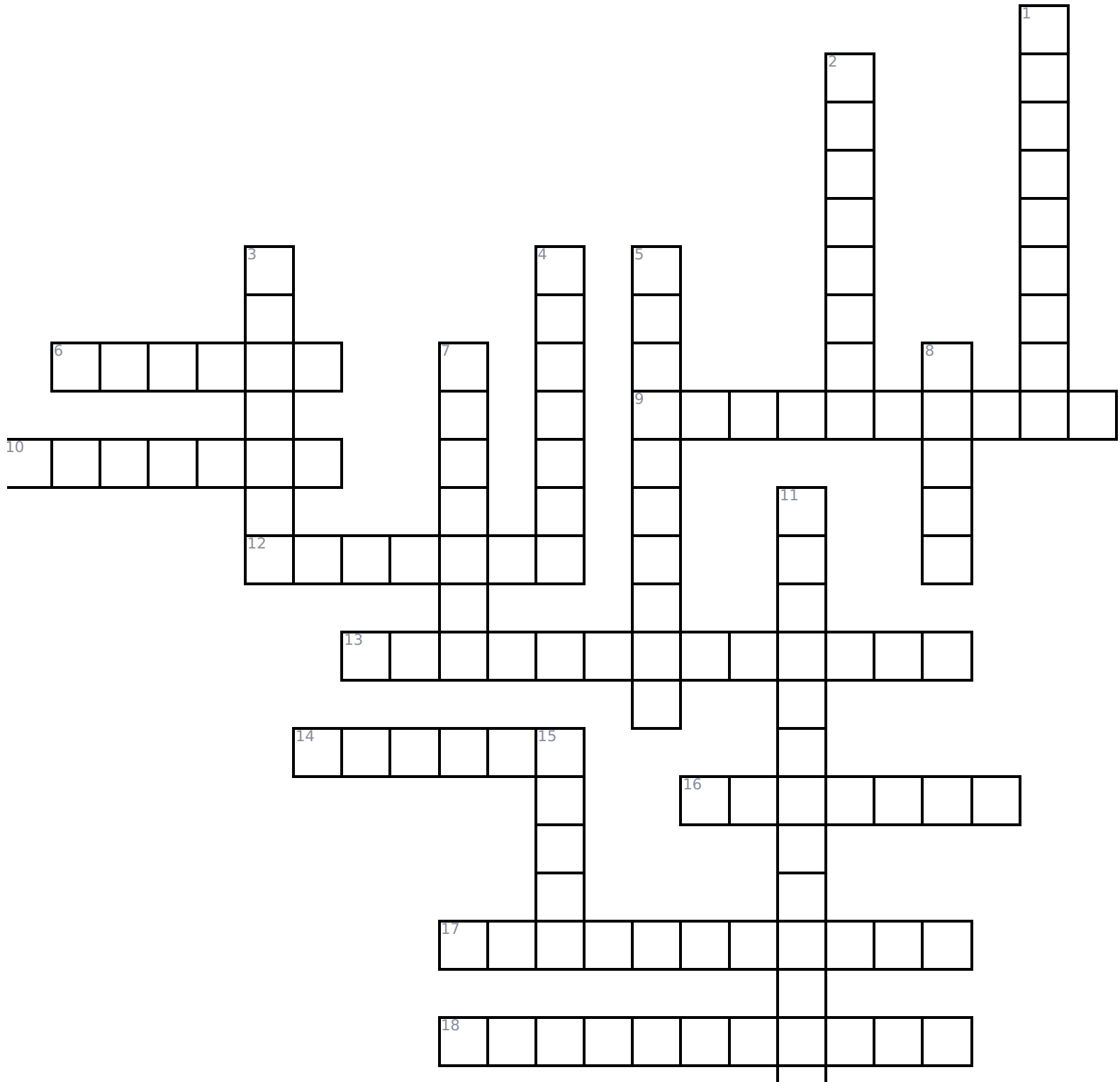


Alone: Criss Cross
