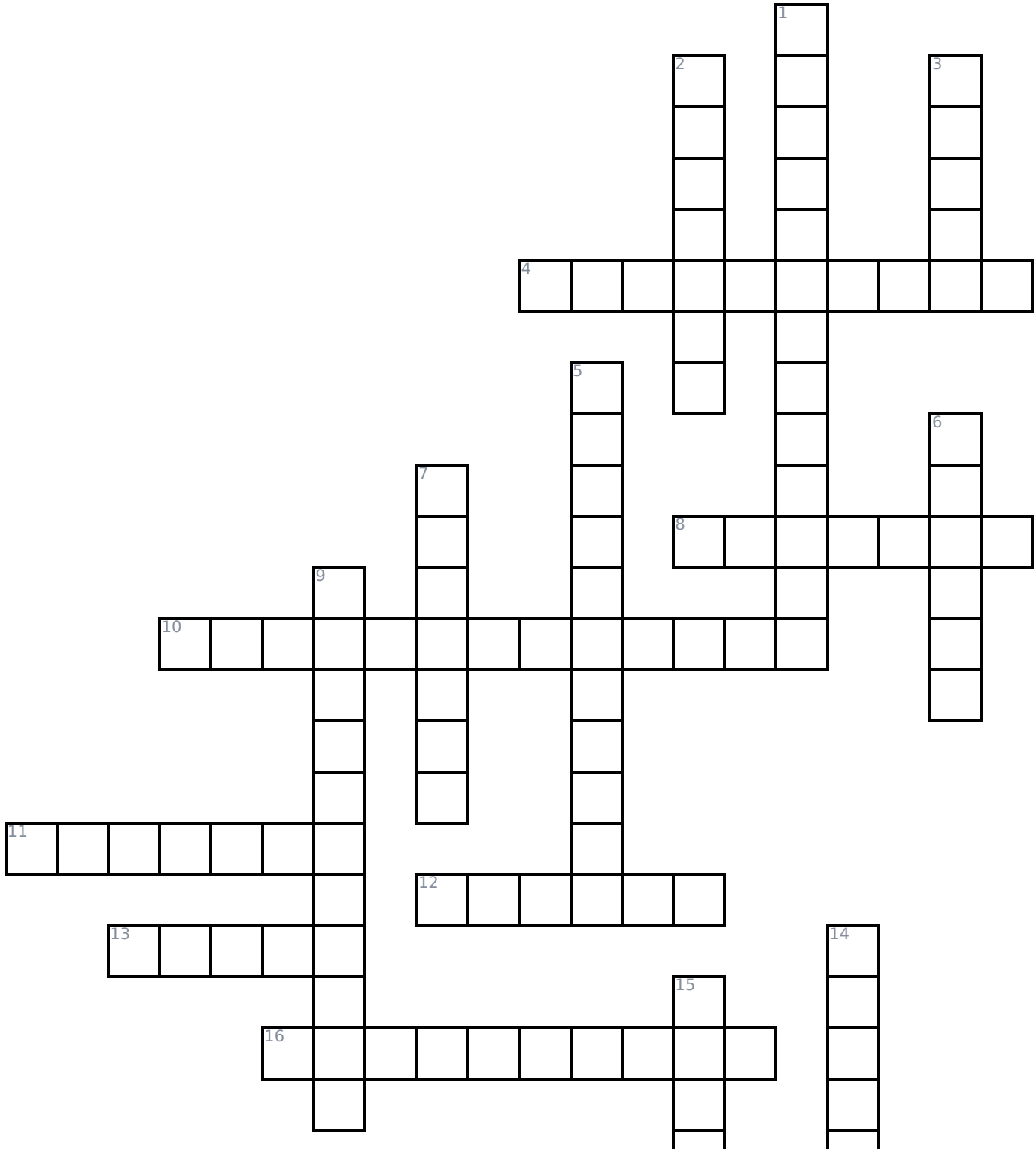
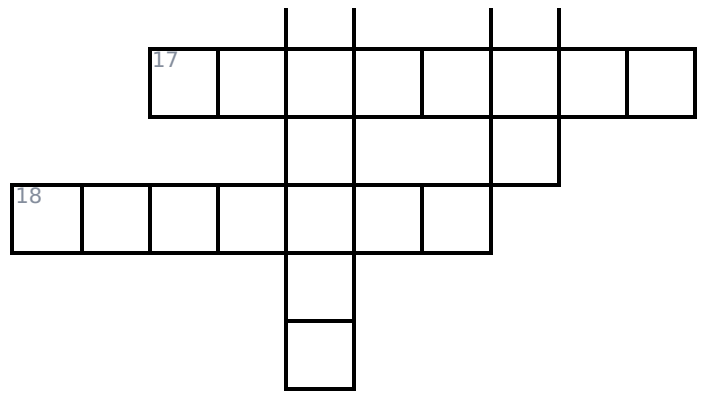


### Alone: Criss Cross
