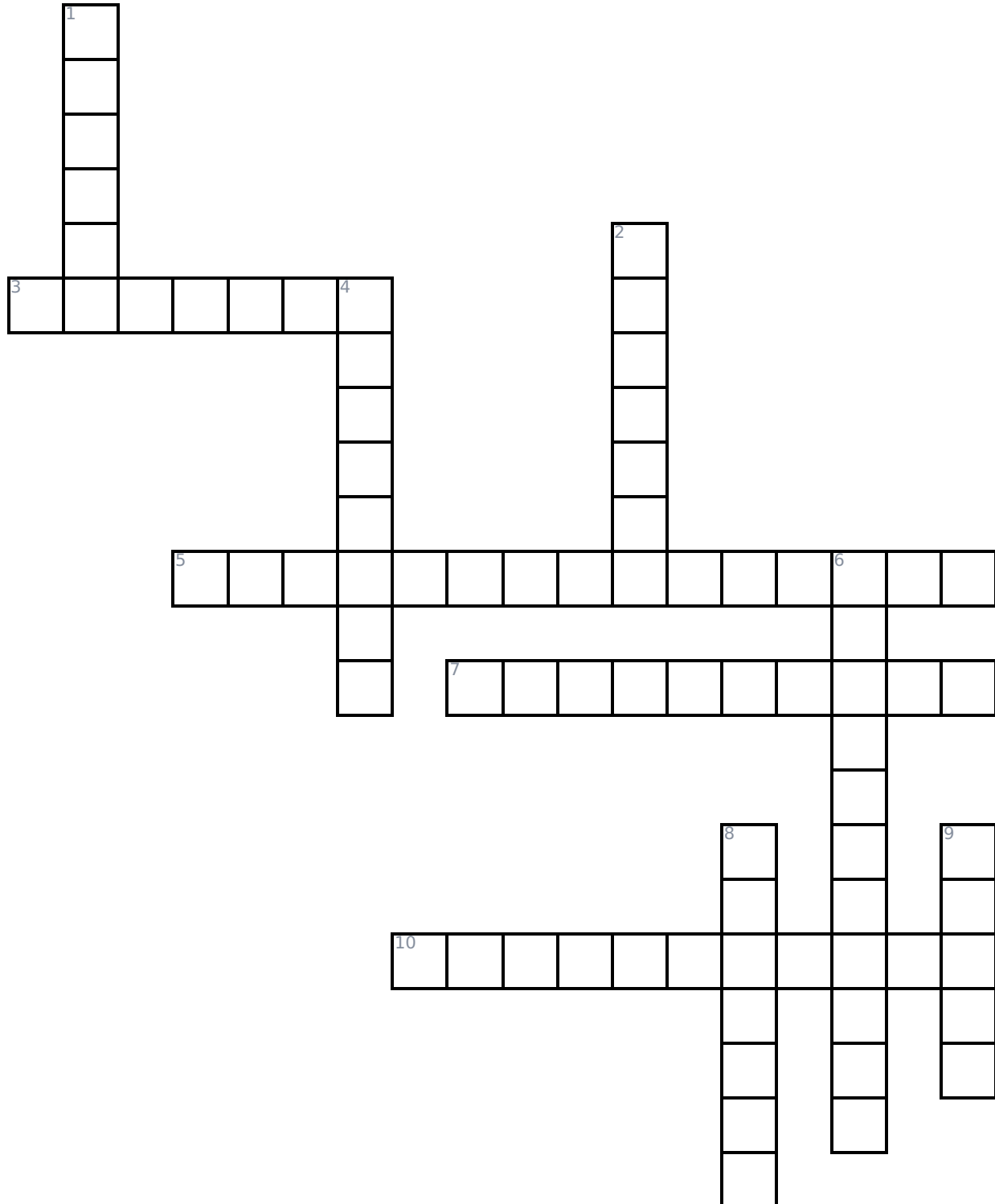


The Boy Who Loved Math: Criss Cross
