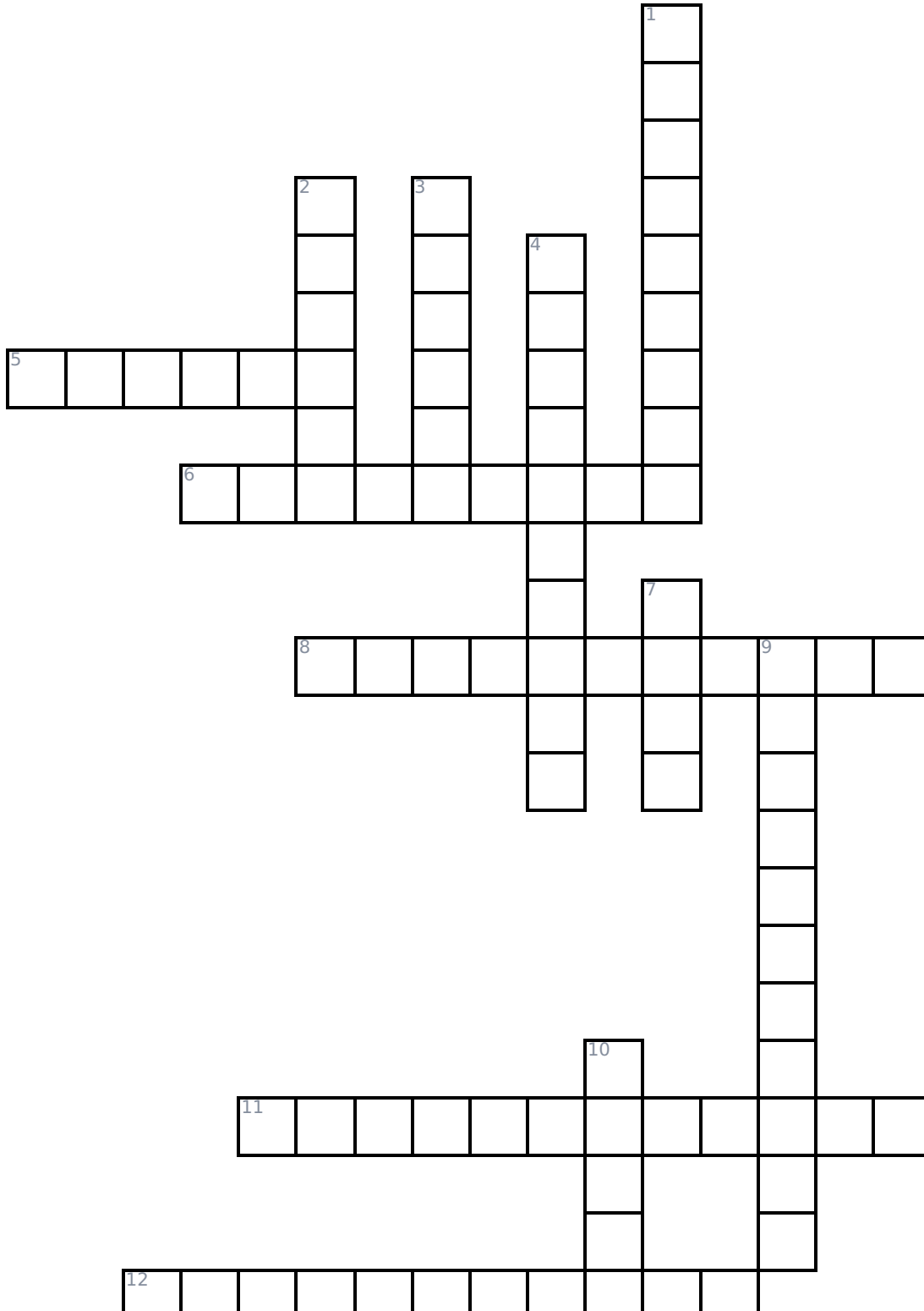
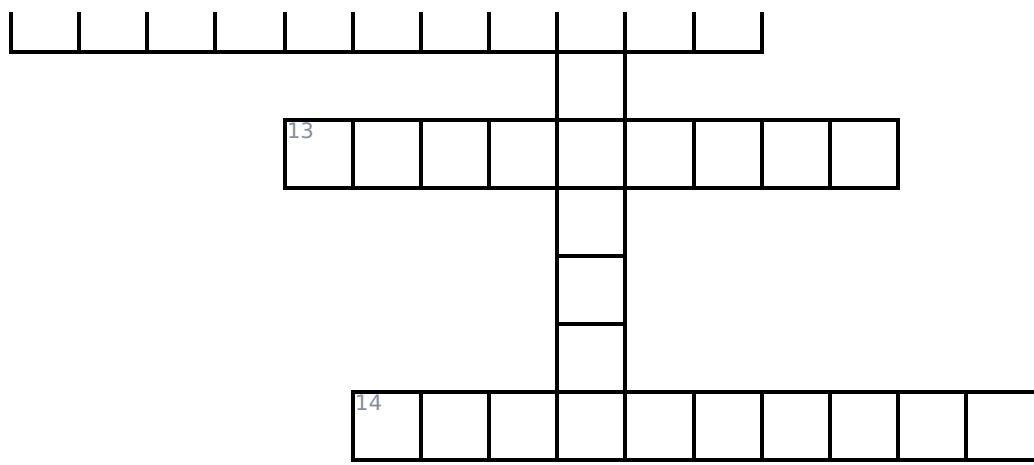


Children of Blood and Bone: Criss Cross
