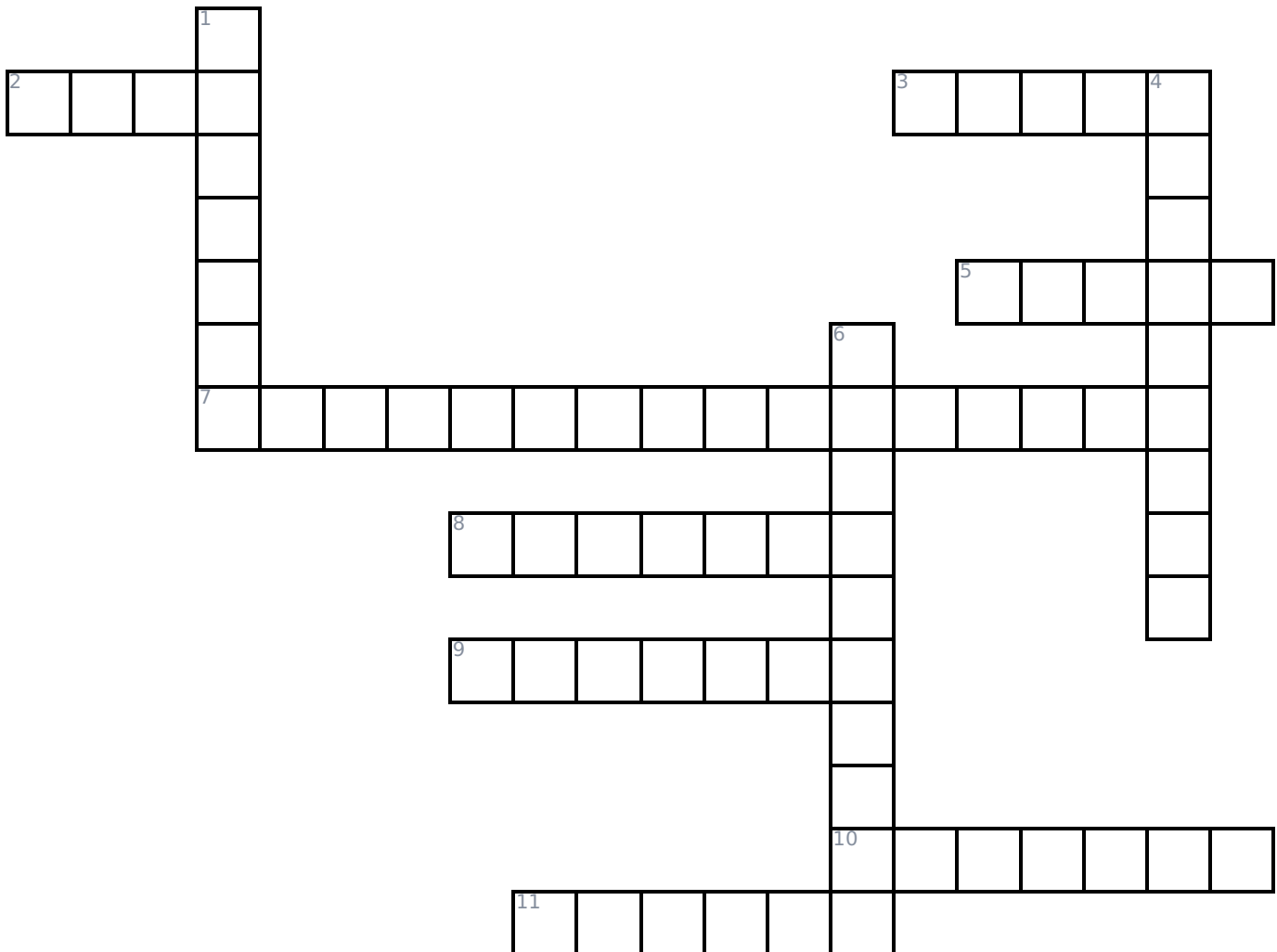


Flying Solo: How Ruth Elder Soared Into America's Heart: Criss Cross
