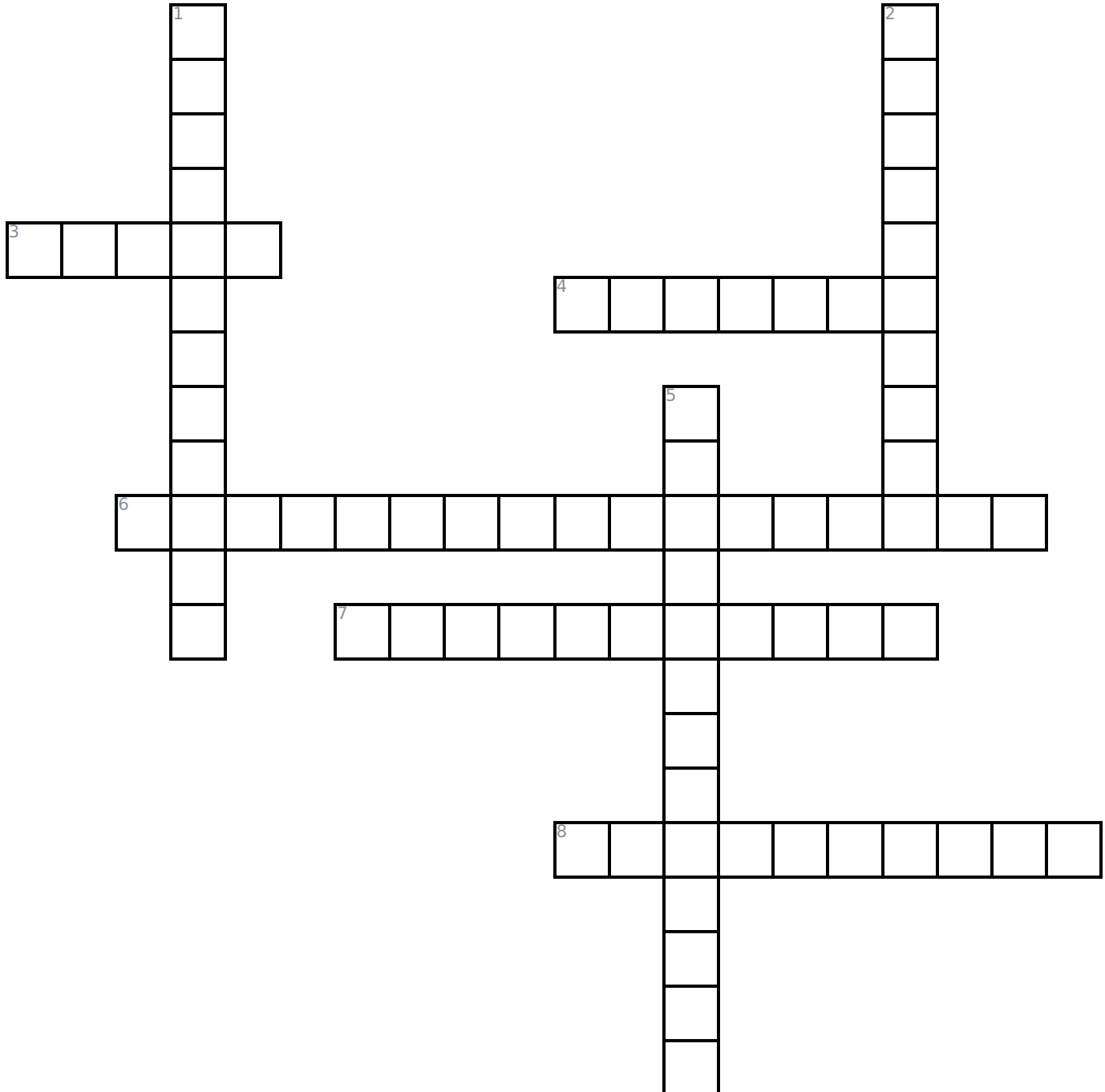


Fresh Air, Clean Water: Criss Cross
