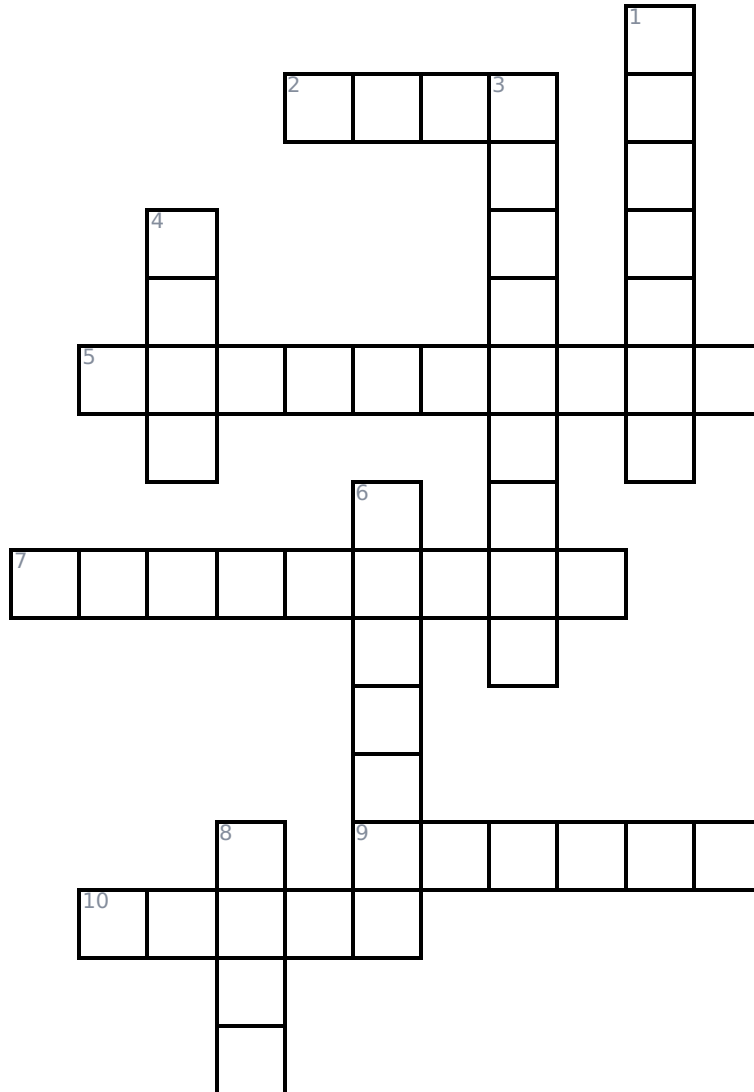


Grandpa's Garden: Criss Cross
