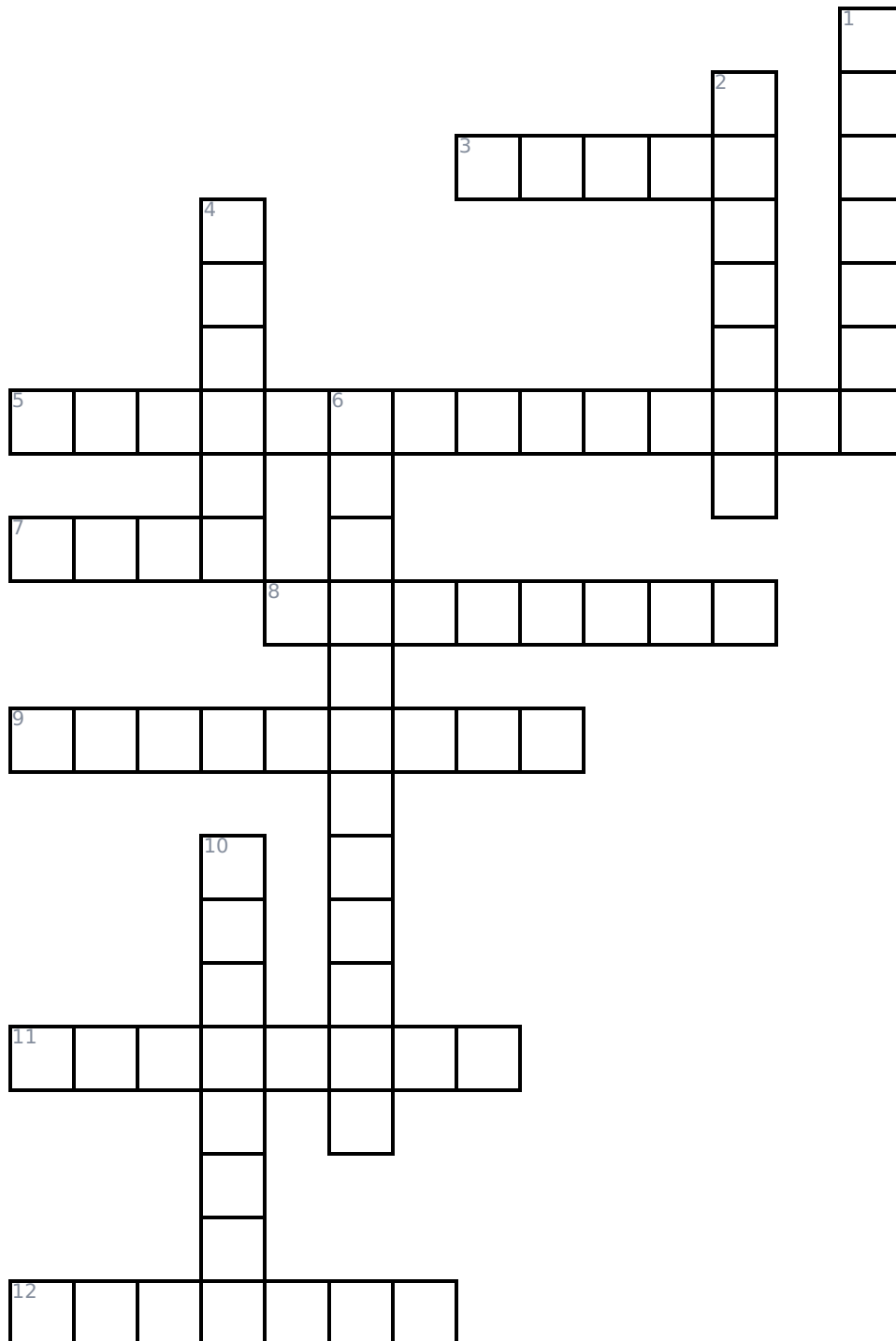


The Internet (Inventions that Changed the World): Criss Cross
