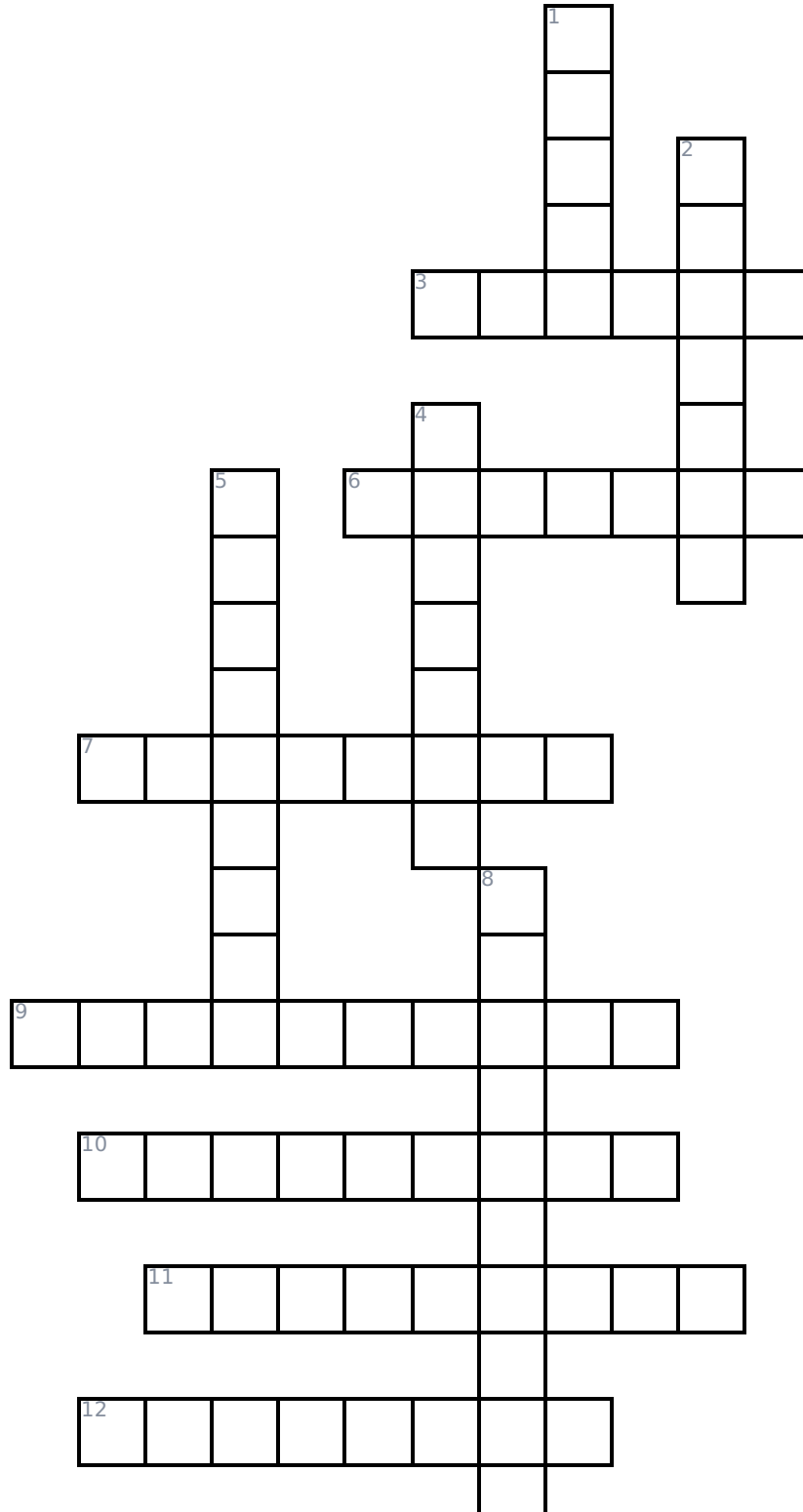


The Night Diary: Criss Cross
