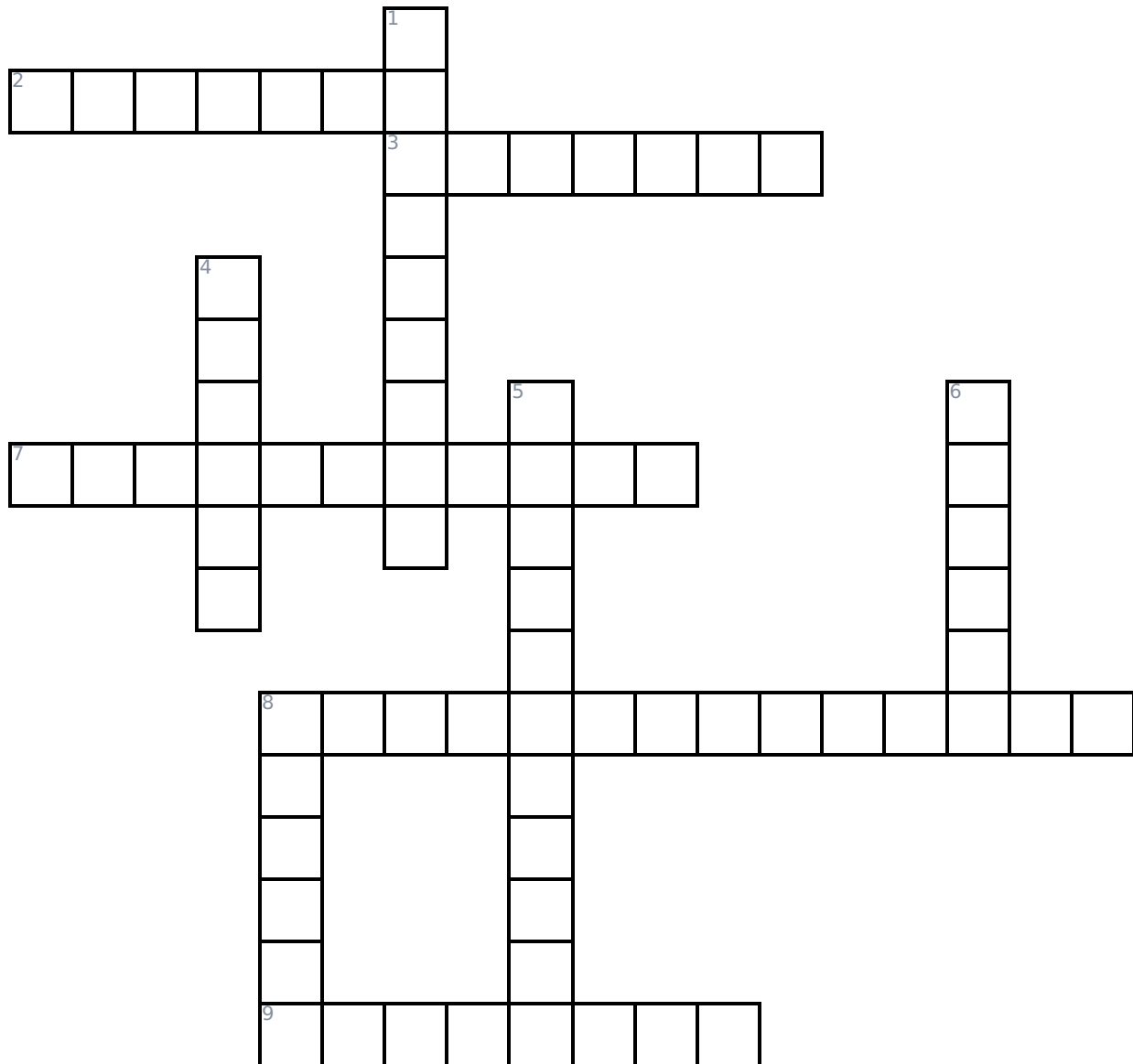


Rachel Carson and Her Book That Changed the World: Criss Cross
