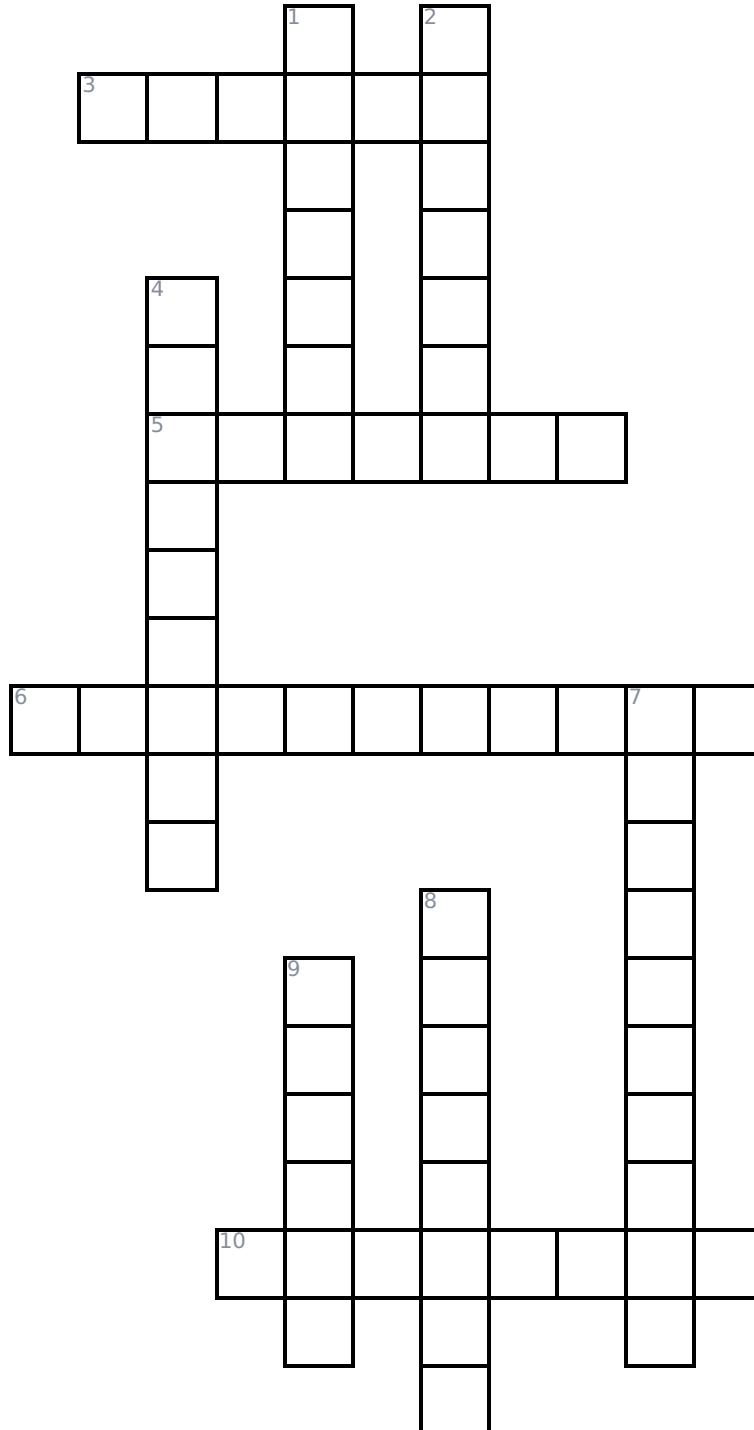


The Television (Tales of Invention): Criss Cross
