RIF NAMED YOUTH NONPROFIT BRAND OF THE YEAR

THE POWER OF CHILDHOOD READING

Variety's annual Power of Women event recognizes philanthropic women across the entertainment industry. As one of the 2018 honorees, Tina Fey selected Reading Is Fundamental as her charity and used her platform to promote the importance of children's literacy. Tina fondly recalls books that shaped her life and future career as a writer, including *A Tree Grows in Brooklyn* and *Black Beauty*. She commented that reading these books as a child helped her develop empathy for others, a quality that eventually pushed her to demand equality in the entertainment business. She also reflected on the joy of receiving free, new books during RIF events in her hometown. Tina closed her remarks by stating simply, "I want to support RIF because reading is power. Reading is access. Reading is the foundation for everything," she said. "Every child should be able to read."

The students participated in a read-aloud and book signing with Clayton, quizzing him on his journeys in space and the role literacy played in his career.
