1. PROVIDE ORGANIZATION INFORMATION:

Books for Ownership, RIF's flagship program, enables children to select new, age-appropriate books to take home and own and is supported by resources for parents, educators, and local literacy advocates to create a continuous focus on reading. With only 1 in 300 low-income children owning a book, this program enables participating children to select books to take home and own for the first time and relies on a simple yet fundamental truth: if you allow children access to and choice of books, they will be more engaged. Over 40 million children nationwide have had the opportunity to experience the power and excitement of this program.
