### BOOKS FOR OWNERSHIP

Focusing on access and choice, children in communities throughout the country participate in RIF's flagship program, Books for Ownership, selecting new, age-appropriate books to take home and own through two annual events focused on increasing motivation and engagement around reading.

Budget: \$3 per book plus additional distribution event costs

### READ FOR SUCCESS

This innovative reading intervention program addresses the literacy backslide that traditionally happens during the summer months by providing access to high-quality classroom book collections, summer books for students to choose and own, enriching STEAM-themed classroom activities, professional development for teachers, and parent engagement resources.

Budget: \$50+ per student depending on the programmatic options you select

### BOOK FUND

Schools, districts, community groups and other youth-serving entities can purchase high-quality, affordable books for the kids you serve. Whether you are looking for books for giveaway prizes, lending libraries or to build home libraries, RIF's Book Fund can provide the titles you need!

Budget: \$3 per book
