As the nation's largest non-profit organization for children's literacy, RIF has curated age-appropriate book lists as well as corresponding literacy activities for each week of the summer. As a parent, a quick registration on RIF's Literacy Central provides full access to over **8,000 free literacy resources** including games, videos, read-aloud books and parent guides. This also includes Puzzle Creator to increase vocabulary through word search, criss-cross and memory match puzzles and BeeLine Reader which displays text using a subtle color gradient wrapping from the end of one line to help developing readers of all levels. Also use the Literacy Central app where an easy scan of a book's barcode unlocks digital resources for on the go reading and engagement.

It's summer and while that means ballgames, barbecues and the beach, we also hope it means **books**. Thank you for being a valuable advocate for reading. Help your student's reading skills take flight and ensure forward progress continues by encouraging reading anywhere and anytime while school is out and finding ways to make reading fun.
