

# Make your own POP-UP!

You will need glue (pritt stick would do) scissors, double sided sticky tape and some thin card (an empty cereal box would be perfect!)

**Remember, always get a grown-up to help you with the cutting out!**

1: Carefully cut out all of the pieces round the blue lines. Glue the large pieces (**pop-up sheet 1** and **pop-up sheet 2**) either side of a piece of thin card. Score down the dotted blue line in the middle and cut out round the solid blue line.

2: Stick **this sheet** onto a piece of thin card. Carefully cut out around the blue lines and lightly score along the dotted lines.

3: Using double sided sticky tape, fix the back of **panel A** on the boy onto the corresponding section marked on **pop-up sheet 1**.

4: Using double sided tape fix the back of **panel B** (on the arm) onto the corresponding section marked on **pop up sheet 1**.

5: Fold the small linking section into an 'n' shape and then stick **panel D** onto the back of the boy and stick **panel C** on to the corresponding section marked on **pop up sheet 1**.

**And that's it, you're done!**
