

To make a flip book you'll need a few items: a small, thick stack of paper (a pad of post it notes works great too), a stapler or paper binder clip to hold the pages together and a pencil. Start drawing your image on the last sheet of paper on the bottom of the stack and work backwards through the stack. Each page should be like the last page you drew but with a slight variation. Your last drawing will be on the top of your stack. Bind the stack together with a stapler or clip and then use your thumb to flip through the images fast. You just made an animation! Enjoy watching your drawing move. Check out how technology has made animation easier. Visit your library and borrow the book *Animation* by Trudi Strain Trueit.
