

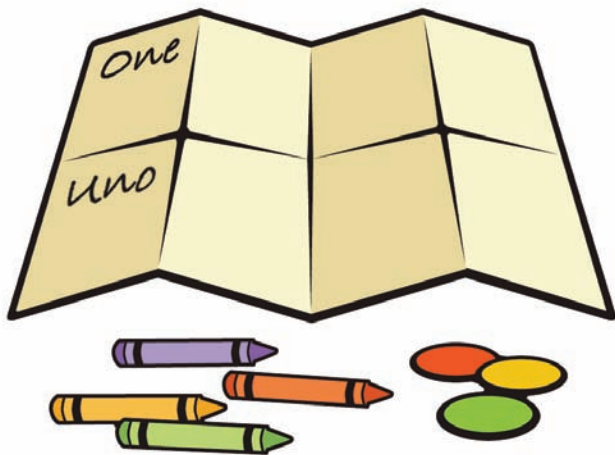

MATH (PRE-K—K)

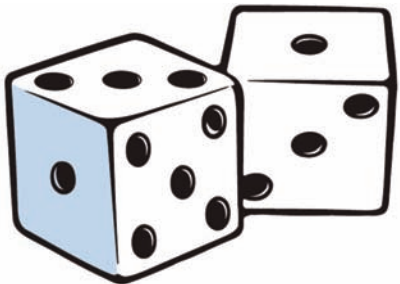

MATH (1ST—2ND GRADE)

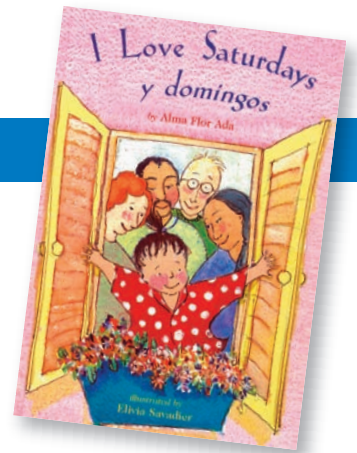
Give a pair of students two dice. Have them roll the dice, add the dots together and respond with the answer in both English and Spanish.
