Wilbur appreciates Charlotte's kindness. And Charlotte appreciates Wilbur's cheerfulness. They are both loyal and caring.

Charlotte wants to help Wilbur feel better about his fate. But she also wants to save him. She continues to write words in her web to tell everyone how wonderful Wilbur is. She calls him four different things, including "some pig" and "terrific."
