

Violet the Snowgirl: A Story of Loss and Healing **Discussion Guide** Grades PK – 3rd

Before Reading: to activate schema, build background knowledge, and set a purpose.

- Preview the title, cover, and illustrations throughout the book to predict the topics of the book.
- Review some vocabulary/terms for the story: feelings, loss, healing, birthday, sadness, memories, grateful

During Reading: to engage students, check for understanding, and make connections.

- Why does Jerzie feel sad the day after her birthday?
- How does building a snowman with her brother make Jerzie feel better and have a good, fun day?
- What makes the melting of the snowman cause sadness for Jerzie and her brother?

After Reading: to summarize, question, and reflect.

- Ask: In pairs or small groups, use a large piece of drawing paper to illustrate the process of building a snowman.
- Make a list of ways that Jerzie & her brother overcome their grief and reflect on the happy times in their lives.
- **Extension:** Use the RIF Venn Diagram graphic organizer to look at the differences & similarities in the feelings of happiness and sadness.
