## **BEFORE READING**

The Cover: Ask students to make a prediction about the story based on the cover.

The Pictures: Take a brief picture walk and ask students what they wonder about.

**Prior Knowledge:** Ask, "Have you ever had a pet? Why might someone want a pet?"

**Vocabulary:** Frontload Tier 2 words using the accompanying <u>Vocabulary Guide.</u>

**Purpose for Reading:** "As we read, pay attention to how the boy cares for his pet."

## **DURING READING**

#### **Check for understanding & make connections:**

- What type of pet does the boy want?
- How do the boy and his pet dragon have fun together?
- If you could have any animal as a pet, what would you choose? Why?

## **AFTER READING**

Our Purpose: How does the boy care for his pet dragon?

**Extending Our Thinking:** Have students use <u>RIF's Writing Template</u> to write a letter to a family member explaining why they want a pet. Encourage them to include specific reasons and details about how they will take care of it.

If your students enjoyed this book...

- Encourage them to continue to discuss it and refer to it in other lessons and conversations.
- Let them explore more about the topic by reading other books with similar themes, structure, characters, or content.
