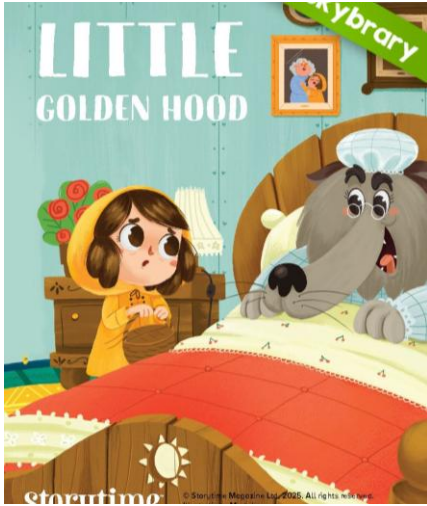


Discussion Guide for Families

Book Brief: Find out what really happened with the big bad wolf.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask your child how they know when it is safe to speak with a stranger.

While Reading: Make Connections

- What could Golden Hood have done differently when she met the wolf?
- What do you think would have happened if grandma was home when the wolf arrived at her house?
- Would you release the wolf? Why?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Think about what Golden Hood could have done to be safer in the forest.

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book, consider:

- Thinking about some dangerous situations the children get into. How could they stay safe in these situations?
Encourage them to draw about it on paper.
