

Book Brief: In this Romanian tale, a busy dad attempts to outwit two dragons and win their gold.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

 Ask your child, "What do you know about dragons – are they scary, friendly?"

While Reading: Make Connections

- What would you do if you met a dragon?
- Do you think Stan was scared? Use the story to prove your answer.
- How would you feed and care for a hundred children?

After Reading: Ask Questions

 Have you ever been given a seemingly impossible task? How did you deal with it? "Share a story about a time when you were brave or thought quickly in a tricky situation?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book, consider:

- Making up a tricky task for someone else to solve it could be a riddle or puzzle.
