READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

• Ask your child if they know who Pirates are, have them mention some of the pirates they have read about. What do pirates do?"

While Reading: Make Connections

- What problems did Leah face in the story? How did she solve them?
- What did Leah and her crew have to do before other ships stopped fighting with them?

After Reading: Ask Questions

 Do you think that Leah learnt how to be a good empress after all her adventures? Explain why you agree or disagree.

- Thinking about designing their own fierce pirate costume. Your child can play dress up or draw a picture of the costume.
