READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

 Ask your child to name some animals that lay eggs. Talk about how they get their eggs to hatch.

While Reading: Make Connections

- What do you think is inside the goose egg?
- What are some of the tasks that Rumble-Mumble did for the king?
- If you were the king in the story, what would you do about Rumble-Mumble?
- Would you try to get rid of him or keep him? How would you take care of him if you decided to keep him?

After Reading: Ask Questions

RELATED ACTIVITIES — If you were Rumble-Mumble, what work would you do to get food?

If your child enjoyed this book, consider:

- Creating your own surprise character that would hatch from the egg.
- Encourage them to draw about it on paper.
