READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

Say, "When something is "unexpected" it means that you didn't think it

While Reading: Make Connections

- What was happening in France? Describe what life was like.
- Why are Joan and her family feeling scared?
- Have you ever felt like no one believed in you and then you proved them wrong? How did that feel?

After Reading: Ask Questions

How did Joan show courage?
