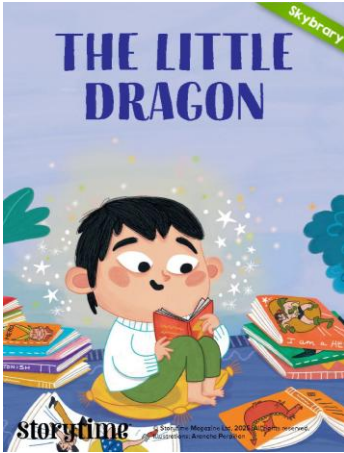


Read Aloud Guide for Families

Book Brief: The thrilling tale of Lee Jun Fon – the child superstar who became a kung fu legend.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, “Have you ever tried something new, like a sport, dance, or hobby, and kept practicing to get better?”
- Explain to your child that this story is about real events, but it is told like a story with characters, a setting, and events in order.

While Reading: Make Connections

- Why does Lee Jun Fan have more than one name? How does he feel about that? Do you know anyone who has a nickname or a special name?
- What is Lee Jun Fan like as a child? Does he remind you of anyone you know?
- Lee Jun Fan works hard to get better at kung fu. What is something you practice at home or school? How do you feel when you get better at it?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, “How did Lee Jun Fan work hard to become a kung fu legend?”
- Why do you think people all over the world still know and honor “Bruce Lee” today?
