#### **READ ALOUD**

### **Before Reading: Build Background**

- Ask, "Have you ever tried something new, like a sport, dance, or hobby, and kept practicing to get better?"
- Explain to your child that this story is about real events, but it is told like a story with characters, a setting, and events in order.

## **While Reading: Make Connections**

- Why does Lee Jun Fan have more than one name? How does he feel about that? Do you know anyone who has a nickname or a special name?
- What is Lee Jun Fan like as a child? Does he remind you of anyone you know?
- Lee Jun Fan works hard to get better at kung fu. What is something you practice at home or school? How do you feel when you get better at it?

## **After Reading: Ask Questions**

- Ask, "How did Lee Jun Fan work hard to become a kung fu legend?"
- Why do you think people all over the world still know and honor "Bruce Lee" today?
