Insistent	When you keep asking or demanding until you get an answer.
Gradual	When something happens slowly, step by step.
Unpredictable	When you can't tell what will happen next.
Ventured	When you bravely go somewhere or try something new, even if it's risky.
Intently	When you pay very close attention to something.
Disoriented	When you feel lost or confused about where you are.
Convinced	When you are sure something is true.
Inquisitively	When you ask questions because you are curious and want to learn more.
Intrepid	When you are brave and not afraid of danger.
Camouflage	When something is hidden by blending in with its surroundings.

Toppled	When something falls over or gets knocked down.
Agitated	When you feel upset, nervous, or stirred up inside.
Frolic	When you play in a happy, energetic way.
Tentatively	When you do something in a careful or uncertain way.
Commotion	When there is a lot of noisy confusion and activity.
Affectionate	When you show that you care about someone with words or actions
Accompanied	When you go somewhere with another person.
Regulate	When you control or adjust how something works.
Formulate	When you carefully plan or think of an idea.

Cease	When something stops or comes to an end.
Conspicuous	When something is easy to see or notice because it stands out.
Trepidation	When you feel nervous or afraid about something that might happen.
