

## Read Aloud Guide for Families



### **The Unstoppable Girl**

**Themes:** Imagination, Determination, The Arts

**Book Brief:** The true story of a brilliant and colorful girl who wouldn't let anything keep her down!

## **READ ALOUD**

### **Before Reading: Build Background**

- Ask, “What does imagination mean to you? Can you think of a time you used your imagination?”
- Explain to your child that this story is about real events, but it is told like a story with characters, a setting, and events in order.

### **While Reading: Make Connections**

- What was Frida like as a child? Are you similar to or different than Frida?
- How does Frida feel about art?
- Describe Frida and her accomplishments throughout her life.

### **After Reading: Ask Questions**

- Ask, “How did Frida overcome her challenges and continue to use her imagination?”

## **RELATED ACTIVITIES**

### **If your child enjoyed this book:**

- Encourage them to explore their creativity through drawing, painting, or storytelling. You can also read more books about artists or imaginative children to inspire curiosity and self-expression.
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
