

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "What does imagination mean to you? Can you think of a time you used your imagination?"
- Explain to your child that this story is about real events, but it is told like a story with characters, a setting, and events in order.

While Reading: Make Connections

- What was Frida like as a child? Are you similar to or different than Frida?
- How does Frida feel about art?
- Describe Frida and her accomplishments throughout her life.

After Reading: Ask Questions

Ask, "How did Frida overcome her challenges and continue to use her imagination?"
