

Book Brief: The story of a boy who always did his

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "Have you ever had to tell the truth about something even when it was hard? How did you feel?"
- Explain to your child that this story is about real events, but it is told like a story with characters, a setting, and events in order.

While Reading: Make Connections

- What does Moniya do when he needs to tell the truth? How does he act?
- How do other people react when Moniya is honest with them?
- Describe a time when being honest was hard for Moniya. What did he do?

After Reading: Ask Questions

Ask, "Why is it important to tell the truth, even when it feels difficult?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Play "Honesty Scenarios." Take turns coming up with pretend situations (like breaking a toy or taking an extra cookie) and talk together about what the honest choice would be and why it matters.
