READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "Have you ever felt really excited about something you wanted to create or do? What inspired you?"
- Explain to your child that this story is about real events, but it is told like a story with characters, a setting, and events in order.

While Reading: Make Connections

- What is Vincent searching for in the story? How does he feel?
- How does Vincent's mood or feelings change throughout the story?
- Describe what Vincent discovers about himself and his art. What inspires him?

After Reading: Ask Questions

 Ask, "How did Vincent find his inspiration? What does it mean to have a 'fire inside'?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Make an "Inspiration Hunt." Go on a walk together and have your child collect or photograph things that inspire them (interesting leaves, colors, textures). Then create art based on what they found.
