

#### **READ ALOUD**

### **Before Reading: Build Background**

- Ask, "What is something important that someone in your family has taught you? How do you use what they taught you?"
- Explain to your child that this story is about real events, but it is told like a story with characters, a setting, and events in order.

# While Reading: Make Connections

- What does Kiki learn from her mother? How does her mother teach her?
- How does Kiki feel about fairness and treating people equally?
- Describe how Kiki uses what she learned as she grows up. What does she do to help others?

## **After Reading: Ask Questions**

 Ask, "How did the lessons from Kiki's mother help her stand up for what is right and fair?"
