
HORSES BINGO



An activity to accompany the book "Around the World on 80 Horses" by Jill Newton.

INSTRUCTIONS

PREPARATION

- Print the breed names and as many bingo cards as you need from this pack.
- Cut the breed names along the dotted lines, then fold the slips of paper and put them into a bowl.
- Gather coins, buttons, pom-poms etc. to use for markers. Have at least 30 – it may be a long game!

HOW TO PLAY

- Place the bowl of bingo markers within reach of all players. Choose a 'caller', who will shake the bowl of horse breed names.
- The caller picks a horse breed out of the bowl and reads it out loud. Any player who has that name on their bingo card then puts a marker on that horse
- The caller continues to pick out names until a player has marked four horses in a row. This can be horizontally, vertically or diagonally. This player then shouts "bingo!"

You can continue until the game a second player shouts "bingo!", or start from the beginning.
