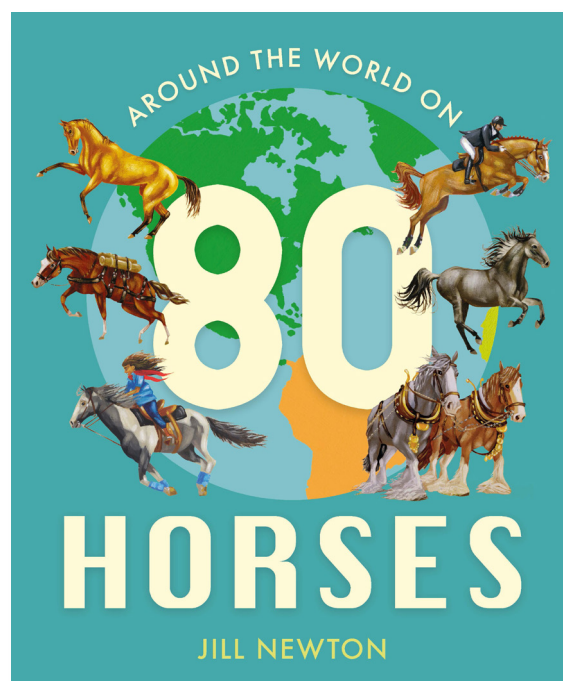

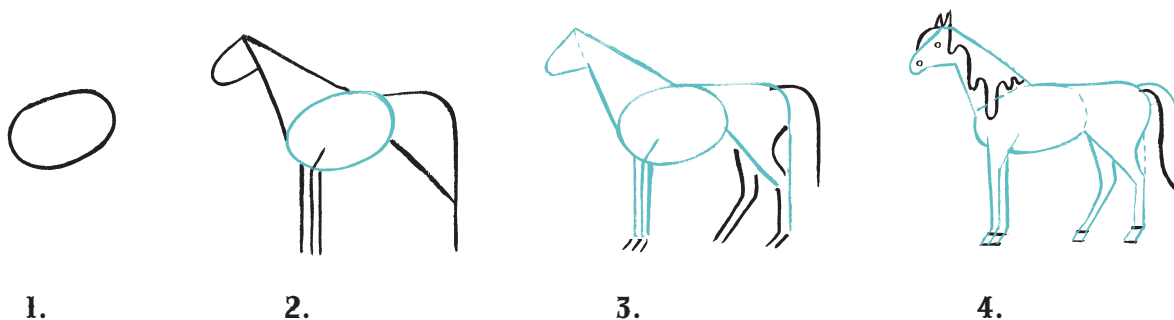

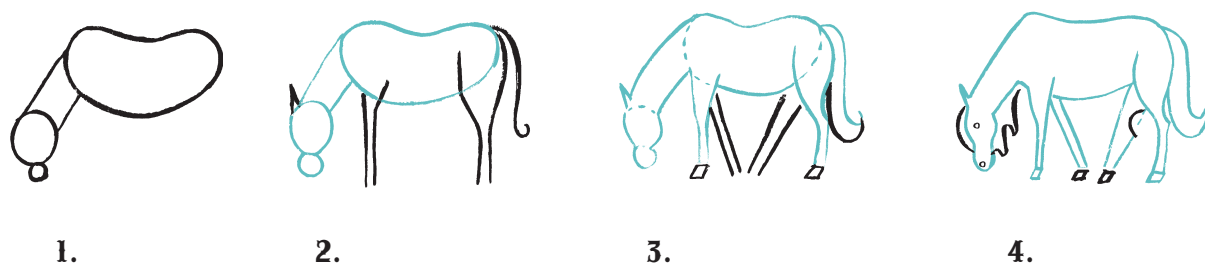
DRAWING HORSES

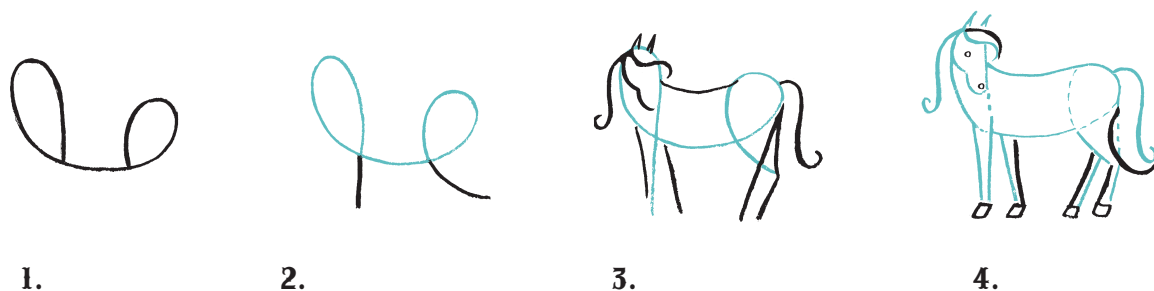

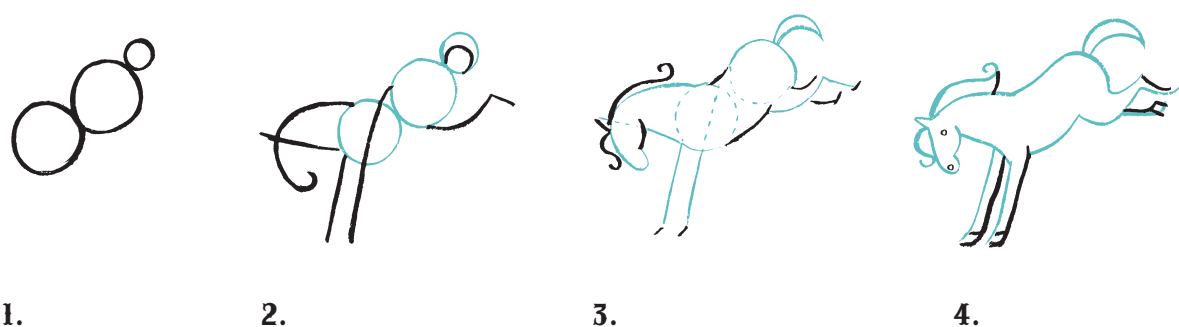
GRAZING



STANDING

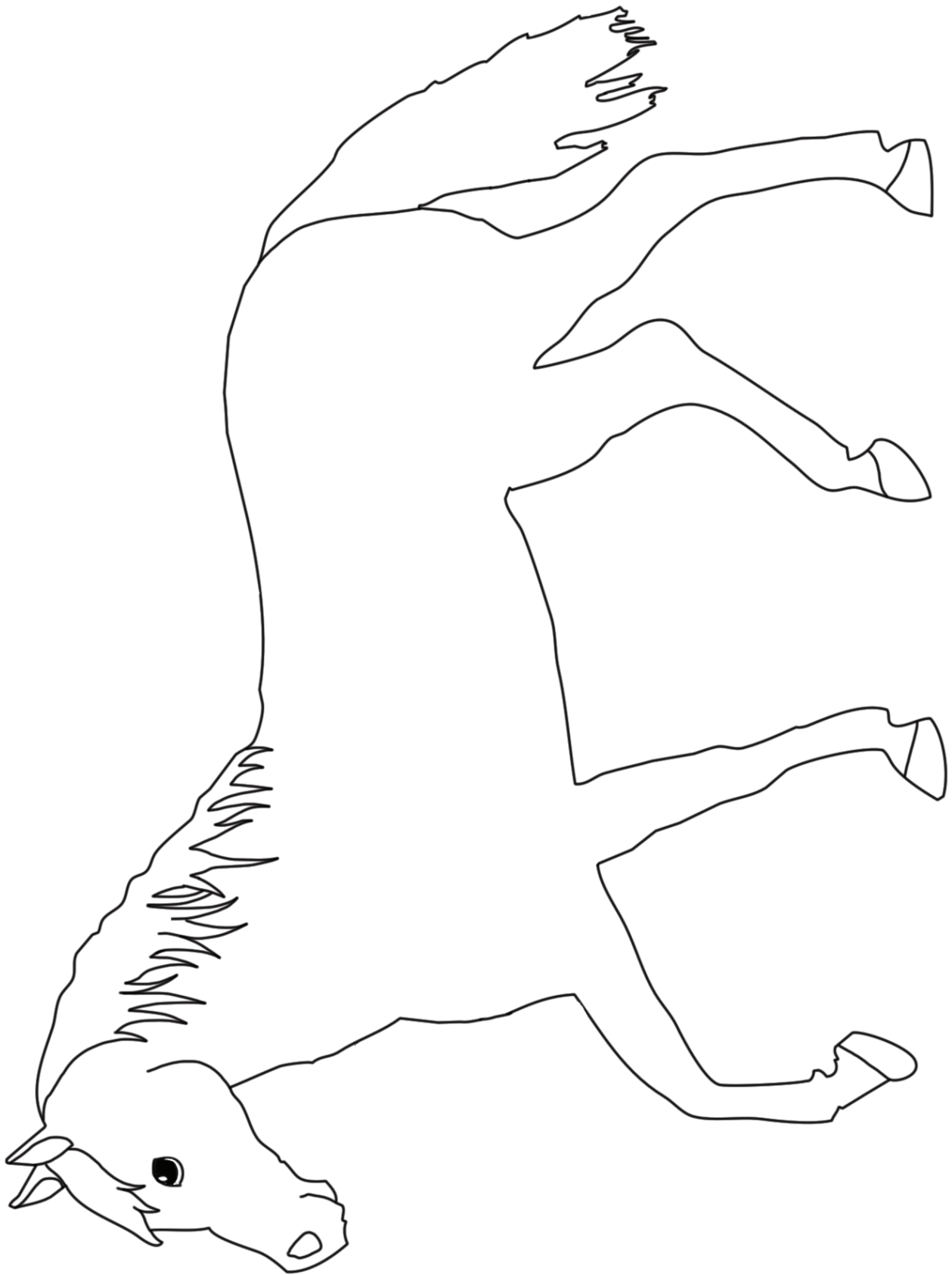


KICKING



COLOR A HORSE

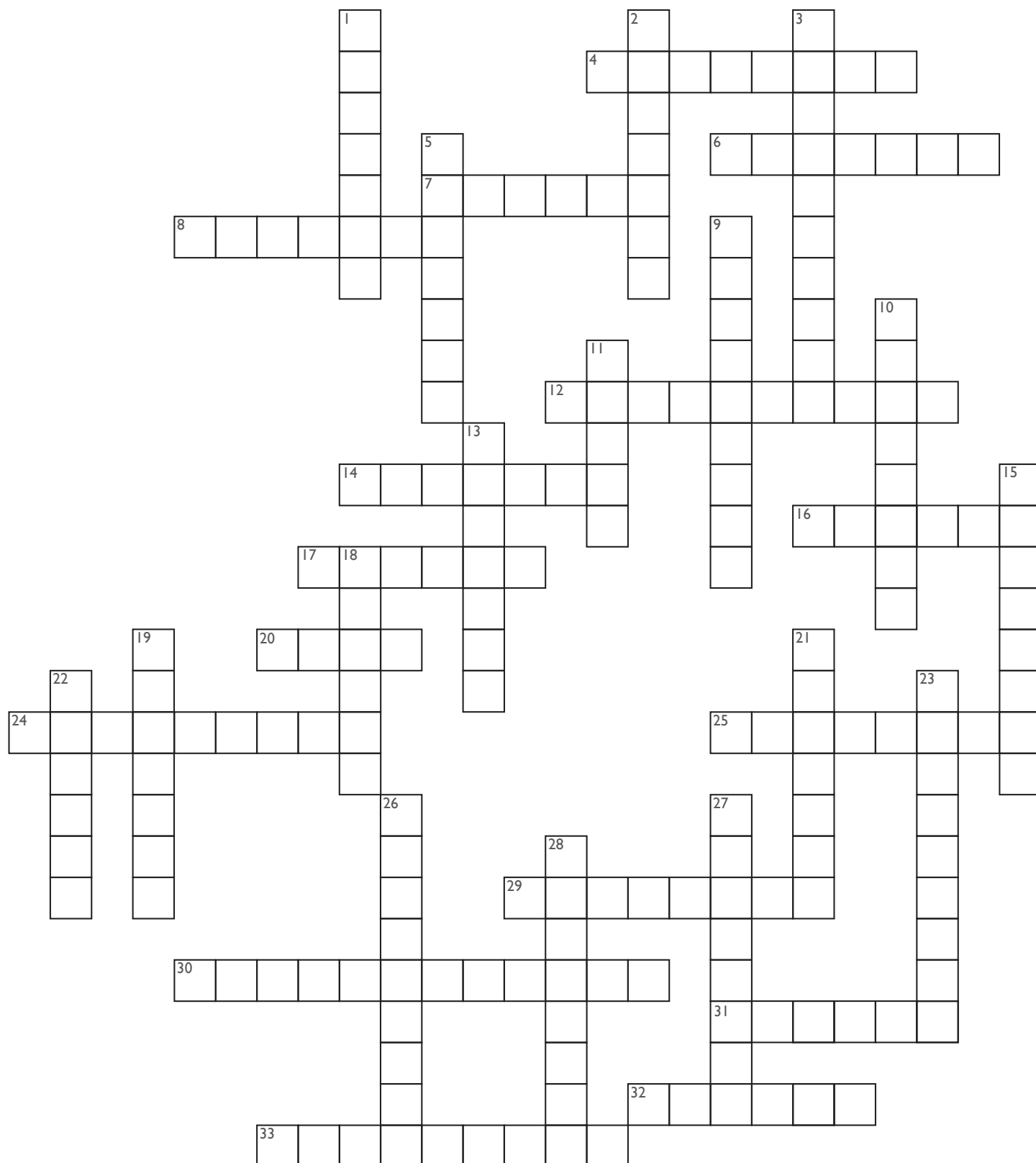
Use pencils, collage, pom-poms, stickers, pens etc. to decorate this horse in any colors you'd like!
