Read Aloud Guide for Families





Seasons / Estaciones

Themes: Early Concepts, Seasons, Bilingual

Book Brief: Little ones learn basic concepts through familiar objects, in both English and Spanish. Picture cues and one-word clues accompany photographs featuring colors, numbers, shapes, and seasons.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "What is your favorite time of year? What do you like to do during that season?"
- Explain to your child that this book teaches about the four seasons in both English and Spanish and shows pictures of things we see and do during each one.

While Reading: Make Connections

- What season are we looking at? What do you see in the pictures?
- How do you say the name of this season in English? Spanish?
- Which season looks the most fun to you? Why?

After Reading: Ask Questions

Ask, "What are the four seasons? What is special about each one?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Make a "Seasons Poster." Fold a large paper into four sections and have your child draw or glue pictures of things they see or do in each season (like snow in winter, flowers in spring, swimming in summer, and leaves in fall). Encourage them to use both English and Spanish words.
- Read more books about weather, nature, or things that change throughout the year.
