Book Brief: Find out about a brave little girl who

changed the world!

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "Have you ever thought something was unfair and wanted to change it? What was it?"
- Explain to your child that this story is about a real girl named Emmeline Pankhurst who saw something unfair in the world and decided to do something brave to change it.

While Reading: Make Connections

- What does Emmeline notice is unfair? How does she feel about it?
- How does Emmeline try to make a difference? What does she do?
- Describe what Emmeline accomplishes. How does she help change things?

After Reading: Ask Questions

Ask, "How did Emmeline's bravery help make the world fairer? What can
we learn from her about standing up for what is right?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Make a "Making a Difference" poster. Talk with your child about something they think is unfair or could be better (at home, school, or in the community). Have them create a poster showing the problem and their ideas for how to make it better, just like Emmeline worked to create change.
