Book Brief: A princess finds that being a pirate is more fun than getting married.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "Do you know what a pirate is? What do they do?"
- Watch a kid-friendly video on pirates to build background knowledge.

While Reading: Make Connections

- What problems did Leah face in the story? How did she solve them?
- What did Leah and her crew have to do before other ships stopped fighting with them?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Do you think that Leah learned how to be a good empress after all her adventures? Explain why you agree or disagree.

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book, consider:

- Encourage your child to imagine a bold pirate outfit! They can either dress up in their creation or draw a picture of what their fierce pirate costume would look like.
