


Read Aloud Guide for Families



Peppa Pig: Family Trip

Themes: Family, Vacation

Book Brief: Peppa and her family set off on a fun trip together. Along the way, they travel, explore new places, and enjoy spending time as a family.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, “If you were going on a long trip, what is one toy or item you would bring with you? Why is it special?”
- Explain to your child that this story takes place in a real country called Italy. Share how families in different parts of the world have different traditions, like the foods they make and eat.

While Reading: Make Connections

- Mummy Pig packs a lot of items for their trip. What important things do you need to pack for a far away trip?
- How does Peppa feel when she realizes she left Teddy behind?
- Describe how Kiki uses what she learned as she grows up. What does she do to help others?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, “What was your favorite part of Peppa’s trip? Why?”

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Plan a trip together: Talk about a place your family would like to visit. Have your child explain what you would do first, next, and last on the trip.
- Family trip retell: Draw three pictures to show what happened at the beginning, middle, and end of Peppa’s family trip.
