


Read Aloud Guide for Families



Little Red Riding Hood

Themes: Safety, Following Directions

Book Brief: A classic tale retold where Little Red Riding Hood learns an important lesson about listening to warnings and being careful on her journey through the woods.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "Have you ever been told to be careful about something? Did you listen? What happened?"

While Reading: Make Connections

- Where is Little Red Riding Hood going? What is she carrying?
- What does her mother warn her about before she leaves?
- Who does Little Red Riding Hood meet in the woods? What does he ask her?
- How did the hunters save Little Red Riding Hood from the wolf?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, "Why did Little Red Riding Hood's mother tell her to stay on the path? What happened because she didn't listen?"
- "How did the wolf trick Little Red Riding Hood? What details in the story show us this?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Create a "Story Map" together. Draw or write the key events in order: Little Red Riding Hood leaves home → meets the wolf → arrives at Grandmother's house → discovers the wolf → gets rescued. Have your child retell the story using these key details.
