


Read Aloud Guide for Families

Themes: Folktale, Family, Courage, Adventure

Book Brief: In this Romanian tale, a busy dad attempts to outwit two dragons and win their gold.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask your child, "What do you know about dragons? Are they scary, friendly?"

While Reading: Make Connections

- Who did Stan meet when he slept in the field of sheep?
- Why did Stan act stronger than he really was?
- How did Stan get the dragon and his mother to give him gold?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, "Have you ever been given a seemingly impossible task? How did you deal with it?" Share a story about a time when you were brave or thought quickly in a tricky situation.

RELATED ACTIVITIES
