Themes: Fairytale, Courage

Book Brief: Find out what really happened with the big bad wolf.

BEFORE READING

The Cover: Ask students to make a prediction about the story based on the cover.

The Pictures: Take a brief picture walk and ask students what they notice.

Prior Knowledge: Ask, "What do you already know about fairytales? Who do you think Little Golden Hood is?"

Vocabulary: Frontload Tier 2 words using the accompanying [Vocabulary Guide](#).

Purpose for Reading: "Let's listen to find out what happens to Little Golden Hood on her walk through the woods."

DURING READING

Check for understanding and make connections:

- Where is Little Golden Hood going?
- Who does she meet in the woods?
- How does the wolf act? Does he seem safe or unsafe?
- What do you notice that tells you something might be wrong?

AFTER READING

Our Purpose: "What choices did Little Golden Hood make, and what happened because of it?"

Extending Our Thinking: Have students compare and contrast this story with another version of the fairytale. Use RIF's Venn Diagram to support deeper learning of the skill.

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
