**Themes:** Determination, Equality, Breaking Barriers

**Book Brief:** The true tale of a girl who loves tennis and is determined to become a champion!

## READ ALOUD

---

### Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "Have you ever loved playing a sport or game so much that you wanted to get better at it? What was it?"
- Explain to your child that this story is about a real tennis player named Billie Jean King who loved tennis and worked hard to become a champion.

### While Reading: Make Connections

- What does Billie Jean love to do? How does she feel about tennis?
- How does Billie Jean practice and improve? What challenges does she face?
- Describe what Billie Jean accomplishes. What makes her a champion?

### After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, "How did Billie Jean's determination and love of tennis help her become a champion? What does her story teach us about working toward our goals?"

## RELATED ACTIVITIES

---

### If your child enjoyed this book:

- Start a "Practice Challenge." Have your child choose a skill they want to improve (like bouncing a ball, drawing, or reading) and practice it a little bit each day for a week. Keep track of their progress and celebrate their improvement, just like Billie Jean practiced to become great at tennis.
