Book Brief: The amazing true story of Mozart, who became one of history's greatest composers and a child superstar!

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "Have you ever watched someone do something and wanted to learn how to do it too? What was it?"
- Explain to your child that this story is about real events, but it is told like a story with characters, a setting, and events in order.

While Reading: Make Connections

- What does young Wolfgang (Wolferl) love? Who does he learn from?
- How does Wolfgang learn to play music? What does he do when he's only three years old?
- What amazing things does Wolfgang accomplish as a child? Where does he perform?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- How did Wolfgang's talent and love of music make him special? What does this teach us about practicing and developing our talents?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Try learning something new by watching and practicing. Choose a simple skill and practice it together regularly. Talk about how practice helps us get better, just like Wolfgang practiced music until he became amazing at it.
