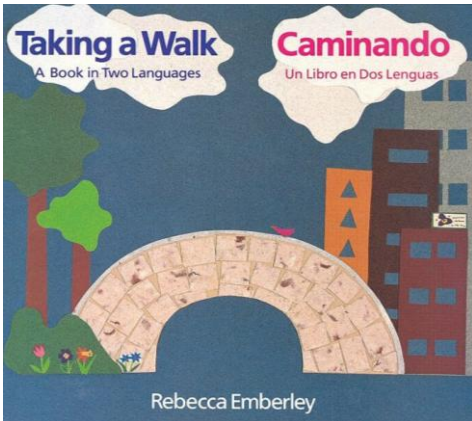


Read Aloud Guide for Families



Taking a Walk / Caminando

Themes: Family, Bilingual

Book Brief: Let's go on a walk together! Along the way, you'll see lots of everyday things and learn what they're called in both English and Spanish. This fun story helps you discover new words while exploring the world around you.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, "What do you see when you go for a walk outside? What are your favorite things to look at?"

While Reading: Make Connections

- What things do you see on the walk? Can you find them in the pictures?
- What new words are you learning in English? What about in Spanish?
- Have you seen these things on your own walks? Where did you see them?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, "What did we see on the walk? Which thing was your favorite? Can you say any of the words in Spanish?"

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Go on your own observation walk! Take a walk outside and point out things you see. Try naming them in both English and Spanish if you remember words from the book, just like in the story.
- Practice saying new words in both English and Spanish from the book together.
