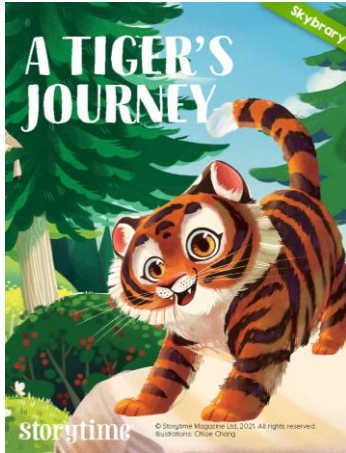


Read Aloud Guide for Families

Themes: Family, Environmentalism, Courage

Book Brief: A powerful story about a Siberian tiger family who must leave their forest home and journey north to find a new home.

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Say, “This book is about a Siberian tiger family that must leave their forest home after it is destroyed and travel together to find a safe new place to live.”
- Ask, “What do animals need to survive in their home?”

While Reading: Make Connections

- Why did the tiger family have to leave their home?
- What challenges do they face on their journey?
- How do they stay safe along the way?
- What signs show that humans are affecting their habitat?
- Where might be a safe new home for them?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, “What happens in the story? Why is it important for animals to have safe habitats? What lesson does this story teach us?”

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Create a Protect the Habitat Poster! Make a poster that shows ways people can help protect animal homes, such as planting trees, reducing pollution, recycling, and keeping forests clean. Include drawings and short labels to show each idea.
