Themes: Superheroes, Helping Others, Kindness

Book Brief: A fun story about Olivia and her mom, two superheroes, who go grocery shopping and discover that being a hero means helping people with small things too!

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, “Have you ever helped someone who needed it? What did you do?”

While Reading: Make Connections

- What is special about the superhero supermarket?
- Why does Olivia think the man is suspicious at first? What clues does she notice?
- How does Olivia help Mr. Moore?

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, “What does Olivia learn about what it means to be a superhero? What are some ways you can be a superhero without having special powers?”

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- **Kindness Challenge:** Choose one kind thing to do for someone else. Afterward, talk about how it made you and the other person feel.
- **Superhero Supermarket Pretend Play:** Create your own superhero store at home. Pretend to shop, help customers, and solve problems using kindness and teamwork.
