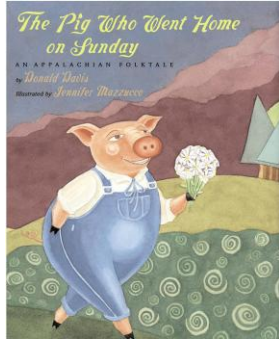


Read Aloud Guide for Families

READ ALOUD

Before Reading: Build Background

- Ask, “Do you already know the story of the Three Little Pigs?”

While Reading: Make Connections

- Think about how each of the three pigs listened or did not listen to their mama.
- Think about the idea of how you would outsmart the fox, like the third pig did.

After Reading: Ask Questions

- Ask, “What did you learn from the story about listening to a parent’s advice?”
- Ask, “What did you learn about outsmarting the fox in the story?”

RELATED ACTIVITIES

If your child enjoyed this book:

- Together, draw an illustration of each pig standing next to the house each built.
